Welcome back after what was hopefully a restful and relaxing break as well as one that was able to recharge the batteries for a busy term ahead!

### **Fundraising for farmers**

They will need to bring a packed recess and lunch for Wednesday and can money for buying food from the canteen and if they wish to buy some snacks along the way. Mrs McGlashan will be transporting all students in the school bus. More information about this will come home later this week.

### NAIDOC sports day

This Friday 3rd August, all students will be travelling to Baradine sports oval, a permission note has been sent home that needs to be returned by Thursday. The cost will be \$3 per student.
