Wow! Who can believe that are nearly at the mid-point of the first term! It certainly is going fast!

Congratulations to all students who competed in the swimming carnival last Wednesday, it was wonderful to watch all students have a go and try their hardest! Unfortunately, Pilliga were far too strong for us on the day! There is always next year!!

Classroom organisation

This year, we are able to once again split students into Infants and primary for 4 days a week. Year 1 and 2 students will be with me and 3-6 students will be with Mrs Knight until lunchtimes. On Monday and Thursday afternoons students will be combined with me and on Tuesday and Wednesdays they will be combined with Mrs Knight. On Fridays all students will be together with Mrs McGlashan. It is hoped that by having such small groups we will be able to have more targeted teaching and achievement growth. There will be days however, that students will be altogether due to teacher absences.

Breakfast club

The school has recently been successful in receiving funding to run a daily breakfast club for all students. It will run from 8:30 until around 8:50am. Students will be able to choose from cereal and toast most days and occasionally they will be offered pancakes, bacon and eggs. As a result of this, morning play will now occur down under the Infants COLA. Breakfast is the most important meal of the day and it is vital that all students have it, as this will assist their learning and concentration in class.

Attendance Matters

Please be aware that it is important that students are at school every day. Obviously if your children are sick, please keep them at home, however reasons such as couldn't find shoes, sleeping in and if it is raining are not justifiable. Students who fall under 85% attendance will be referred to the Home School Liaison Officer for follow up. It is anticipated that students should be at school 95% of the time. Please find attached more information about why attendance is important. Students who display exemplary attendance will be rewarded at the end of the year.

Canberra Excursion

The Canberra excursion is planned for Week 7 of Term 4 this year, 15th-19th November. As this will be an extremely busy time in Canberra as many schools will be on excursion at the same time, it is important that we lock in final numbers now. Students will be travelling in the school bus and will be staying in 2 bedroom apartments in Manuka. There will be a staff member in each room with each family of children. The cost will be \$330 per student., the school is heavily subsidising the excursion as well. All money must be paid by Friday November 5 2021. Payment plans are available. By paying as little as \$15 per student a week, the excursion will be paid for by 5/11. A draft itinerary is attached.

Radio show return



The school radio show has returned fortnightly on Thursdays. Our next show will take place on Thursday 25th February.

Sport on Thursdays

We will be continuing sport on Thursdays at Pilliga for the next 3 weeks. A permission note was sent home yesterday. Please ensure that it is filled in and sent back to school. Students must be wearing their full sports uniform on Thursdays-no football shorts.

School money envelopes

Ensure that child's name is written on the front, what the money is for and how much money is in the envelope. If you need more, please contact the front office. Correct change is preferred.

Homework



Students in Years 1-6 have been given spelling homework which must be completed and handed in on a Friday. Kindergarten students have sounds work to complete. Students will be allowed to keep the iPads at home that they used throughout the Learning from Home time. They are required to read a PM book every night and record it. They are also required to complete either 1 map in Reading eggs/ Reading eggspress or 1 map in Maths seeds every night. It is important that students complete this as it supports what they are learning at school. This should take approximately 30 minutes to complete.

Parents and carers can help foster positive attendance habits by:


- helping their child learn the importance of punctuality and routine



School attendance


Regular attendance at school is important!
